3. The Clerk of Court is **DIRECTED** to **AMEND** the caption in the Consolidated Action (No. 24-2961) to reflect all of the above-referenced parties and all attorneys of record.

4. Any action subsequently filed in, transferred to, or removed to this Court that arises out of the same or similar operative facts as the Consolidated Action shall also be consolidated with the Consolidated Action for all purposes and **STAYED**. The parties in any subsequent case shall file a Notice of Related Action whenever a case that should be consolidated with this action is filed in, transferred to, or removed to this District.

5. Counsel shall only file motions or papers in the Consolidated Action (No. 24-2961).

6. This Order shall apply to the above-captioned cases and to any related and subsequently consolidated cases.

7. The Court will hold a hearing on **September 5, 2024**, at **10:30 a.m.** in Courtroom 12-A of the United States Courthouse, 601 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19106 to discuss:

- a. The appointment of Interim Co-Lead Counsel, if any, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(g);<sup>1</sup>
- b. The appointment of Plaintiffs’ Executive Committee members, if any;
- c. The appointment of Liaison Counsel, if any; and

<sup>1</sup> Rule 23(g)(3) allows the Court to “designate interim counsel to act on behalf of a putative class before determining whether to certify the action as a class action.” Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(g)(3). When attorneys are seeking appointment as interim class counsel, the Court must consider:

- (i) the work counsel has done in identifying or investigating potential claims in the action;
- (ii) counsel’s experience in handling class actions, other complex litigation, and the types of claims asserted in the action;
- (iii) counsel’s knowledge of the applicable law; and
- (iv) the resources that counsel will commit to representing the class.

Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(g)(1)(A). The Court must also ensure that the proposed class counsel can “fairly and adequately represent the interests of the class.” Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(g)(4).

- d. The establishment of a schedule for the filing of an operative, consolidated complaint and other pretrial matters.
