**JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE DEADLINE
FOR SUBMISSION OF PROPOSED FINAL ORDER**

NOW INTO COURT, through undersigned counsel, come Plaintiff Ellen Berman and Defendant General Motors LLC (“GM”), who jointly request a one-week continuance of the October 25, 2019 deadline for Class Counsel to file a revised proposed final order and notices in connection with final approval of the class action settlement after representing as follows:

1. On October 4, 2019, this Court held a final fairness hearing in connection with the parties’ proposed class action settlement.

2. At the hearing, the Court requested that by “October 25, 2019, Class Counsel shall file a revised proposed final order consistent with the parties’ agreement at the hearing and memorialized in the hearing transcript, which proposed order shall also include as an exhibit a revised form of notice to all existing class members as well as to those who previously opted out of the settlement class.” Dkt. 156.

4. However, the parties require one (1) additional week, up to and including November 1, 2019, within which to complete all tasks.
