Re: Incident Notification

Dear Sir or Madam:

We are writing on behalf of CNHI, LLC ("CNHI") to notify you of a security incident.

CNHI concluded its investigation of an incident involving unauthorized access to its computer network. Upon discovering the incident, CNHI secured its network and commenced an investigation. The investigation determined that an unauthorized actor accessed its computer network between April 27, 2025 and May 17, 2025, and took certain files. CNHI reviewed the files involved and on November 19, 2025, CNHI identified one or more files containing the names of 847 New Hampshire residents and one or more of: Social Security number, driver's license number and/or financial account number.

On December 8, 2025, CNHI began mailing notification letters via U.S. First-Class mail to the New Hampshire residents whose information was contained in the files involved in the incident. A copy of the notification is enclosed. CNHI is offering one-year of complimentary credit monitoring and identity theft protection services to the notified individuals whose Social Security or driver's license numbers were contained in the involved files. CNHI has also established a toll-free call center to answer any questions notified individuals may have.

To help prevent something like this from happening again, CNHI has taken steps to enhance its existing security protocols.
