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Notice of Data Event

September 4, 2026

Philadelphia, PA – COMHAR, Inc. ("COMHAR") is notifying individuals who may have been impacted by a data event. COHMAR recently identified unusual activity on its network. In response, COHMAR quickly began working with third-party specialists to investigate and determine the full nature and scope of the activity. On July 17, 2026, the investigation determined that certain files and folders were copied by an unknown actor on or before July 17, 2026. Therefore, COHMAR is undertaking a comprehensive review of the relevant files and folders to determine the full nature and scope of the information at risk. This review is currently ongoing.

Although the review remains ongoing, the type of information potentially impacted may include an individual's name, address, date of birth, Social Security number, treatment notes, diagnosis, medications, and health insurance information.

In response to the event, COHMAR took steps to ensure the security of the data stored on its systems and conducted a comprehensive investigation with the assistance of computer specialists. COHMAR is also taking steps to further enhance its cybersecurity posture by reviewing and implementing, as needed, additional policies and procedures.

Individuals are encouraged to remain vigilant against incidents of identity theft and fraud by reviewing credit reports/account statements and explanation of benefits forms for suspicious activity and to detect errors.
