Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) and Local Rule 7.2 of the United States District Court for the Southern District of California, Plaintiffs, Matt Goldstein, Vanessa Rodriguez, Benito Guzman, and Percy Sutton ("Plaintiffs"), by and through their attorneys, and Defendant General Motors LLC ("Defendant" or "GM"), by and through its attorneys, (collectively, the "Parties"), hereby jointly move and respectfully request that the Court dismiss this action with prejudice as to Plaintiffs' individual claims, and without prejudice as to the claims of the putative class members.

Plaintiffs filed their operative Third Amended Complaint on March 5, 2021 (Dkt. 67), which GM answered on March 8, 2022 (Dkt. 83).

The Parties have reached a confidential settlement in this action.

The Parties stipulate and agree, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), that Plaintiffs voluntarily dismiss this action <u>with prejudice</u> as to Plaintiffs' individual claims, and <u>without prejudice</u> as to the claims of the putative class members.

"Because no class has been certified in this case, Rule 23 does not mandate either Court approval of the instant settlement or notice to putative class members." *Lee v. CVS Pharmacy, Inc.*, No. 320CV01923BENDEB, 2021 WL 308283, at *2 (S.D. Cal. Jan. 28, 2021) (alterations and quotations omitted). Instead, "when no class has been certified, voluntary dismissal of a putative class action is governed not by Rule 23 but by Rule 41." *Adams v. USAA Cas. Ins. Co.*, 863 F.3d 1069, 1082-83 (8th Cir. 2017) (collecting cases). Thus, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), the Parties hereby stipulate and jointly move the Court for dismissal of this entire action with prejudice as to Plaintiffs' individual claims, and without prejudice as to the claims of the absent putative class members.
