1. Based on the unopposed submissions by the Plaintiffs, the Court hereby grants preliminary approval of the Settlement reached between the parties as set forth in their Class Action Settlement Agreement and Release dated August 2, 2025 (the "Settlement Agreement").  
as defined in paragraph 1.30 of the Settlement Agreement
2. The Court provisionally certifies the requested Settlement Class under Article 9 of the CLPR for settlement purposes only.
3. The Court appoints Philip L. Fraietta, Esq. and Stefan Bogdanovich, Esq. of Burson & Fisher P.A. as Class Counsel.
4. The Court appoints Epiq Systems, Inc. ("Epiq") as the Settlement Claims Administrator and directs Epiq to administer the settlement in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement.
5. The Court approves the proposed Class Notice and Claim Form and directs its distribution to the Settlement Class consistent with the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

6. The Court approves the deadlines set forth in the Settlement Agreement for Class Members to submit Claims Forms, objections, or requests for exclusion from the Settlement Agreement.
7. The Motion for Final Approval of the Settlement Agreement, if any, will be heard on April 15, 2026, 2025, and Plaintiffs shall file their Motion for Final Approval of the Settlement Agreement no later than seven days before such hearing. The Court retains discretion to issue an Order on Plaintiffs' Motion for Final Approval of the Settlement Agreement based on the motion papers in the event no objections are filed. Plaintiffs' counsel shall notify the court of any objections at least seven days before the hearing date.
