**Re: Notice of Cybersecurity Incident Involving Southern Illinois OB-GYN**

Dear Attorney General Formella:

Wilson Elser Moskowitz Edelman and Dicker LLP (“Wilson Elser”) represents Southern Illinois OB-GYN (“SOILOGYN”) (500 Rushing Drive, Herrin, IL 62948) with respect to a cybersecurity incident that was first discovered by SOILOGYN on November 24, 2025, (hereinafter, the “Incident”). SOILOGYN takes the security and privacy of the information in its control very seriously and has taken steps to prevent a similar incident from occurring in the future.

This letter will serve to inform you of the nature of the Incident, what information may have been compromised, the number of New Hampshire residents being notified, and the steps SOILOGYN has taken in response to the Incident.

**1. Nature of the Incident**

On November 24, 2025, SOILOGYN detected suspicious activity on their network that resulted in a network interruption. SOILOGYN immediately isolated the impacted environment and worked with its IT professionals and outside experts to secure and remediate the server. SOILOGYN engaged a third-party cybersecurity firm to conduct a comprehensive forensic investigation to determine the nature and scope of the incident. On or about December 6, 2026, the investigation determined that an unauthorized third-party potentially viewed and/or downloaded data stored on certain of SOILOGYN’s systems.

Based on these findings, SOILOGYN conducted a comprehensive and thorough review of the potentially impacted data to identify the specific individuals and the types of information that may have been compromised. On May 4, 2026, SOILOGYN finalized the list of individuals to notify. The type of information that may have been compromised includes individuals’ names, Social Security numbers, dates of birth, demographic information, health insurance numbers, and health information.

**2. Number of New Hampshire residents affected.**

A total of six (6) New Hampshire residents may have been potentially affected by this Incident. Notification letters to these individuals will be mailed on May 19, 2026 by U.S. mail. A sample (redacted) copy of the notification letter is included with this letter as **Exhibit A**.

**3. Steps taken in response to the Incident.**

Data privacy and security is among one of SOILOBGYN's highest priorities, and SOILOBGYN is committed to doing everything it can to protect the privacy and security of the personal information in its care. Since the discovery of the Incident, SOILOBGYN immediately isolated the impacted systems and worked with IT professionals and outside experts to secure and remediate these systems. SOILOBGYN engaged a third-party cybersecurity firm to conduct a comprehensive forensic investigation to determine the nature and scope of the Incident. Furthermore, SOILOBGYN is implementing additional technical safeguards, enhanced security measures, and updated policies and procedures to mitigate against the risk of future issues.

SOILOBGYN is also offering twelve-months months of complimentary credit monitoring and identity theft restoration services to the impacted residents. Additionally, SOILOBGYN provided guidance on how to better protect against identity theft and fraud, including providing information on how to place a fraud alert and security freeze on one's credit file, the contact details for the national consumer reporting agencies, information on how to obtain a free credit report, a reminder to remain vigilant for incidents of fraud and identity theft by reviewing account statements and monitoring free credit reports, and the contact details for the Federal Trade Commission.
