PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on August 12, 2026, the Court issued its ruling on Plaintiff Jessica Ratzak's unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, granting the motion. The substance of the Court's tentative ruling is set forth below:

The unopposed motion is granted.
The court has broad discretion in determining whether a class action settlement is (1) fair and reasonable, (2) the class notice is adequate, and (3) certification of the class is proper. (In re Cellphone Fee Termination Cases (2010) 186 Cal.App.4th 1380, 1389.) The court has carefully considered the class action settlement agreement (Friedman Decl., Exh. A), plaintiff's moving papers in connection with the motion filed February 20, 2026, the supplemental declarations of counsel Friedman filed June 16, 2026 and August 4, 2026, and the entire court file. The court determines a sufficient showing has been made that the class action settlement is fair, adequate, and

1 reasonable. The court preliminary approves the class action settlement agreement attached as
2 Exhibit A to the February 20, 2026 declaration of counsel Friedman. The court also approves the
3 proposed form of notice attached as Exhibit B to the February 20, 2026 declaration of counsel
4 Friedman.

5 As to the proposed form of notice attached as Exhibit C to the February 20, 2026 declaration of
6 counsel Friedman, the court observes item 14 states the final approval hearing will be in Department
7 6 before the Honorable Garen Horst at 101 Maple Street, Auburn, CA 95603. Item 14 of Exhibit C
8 should dictate Department 32, the Honorable Trisha J. Hirashima, and the address of 10820 Justice
9 Center Drive, Roseville, California 95678. With those changes, the court also approves the proposed
10 form of notice attached as Exhibit C to the February 20, 2026 declaration of counsel Friedman.

11 For the purposes of the settlement, the court hereby certifies the class as 'all persons within the
12 United States who purchased the following Thinkware Products between January 25, 2019 and
13 August 31, 2024: X700 dash cams, F200PRO dash cams, DC-M2FG-IR dash cams, DC-M2-FG
14 dash cams, and F70PRO dash cams,' excluding members of the court, class counsel, Thinkware and
15 its employees and agents.

16 The court preliminarily appoints and designates Jessica Ratzak as the class representative. The court
17 preliminarily appoints and designates Adrian R. Bacon and Todd M. Friedman of the Law Offices
18 of Todd M. Friedman, P.C. as class counsel.

19 The court appoints and designates Eisner Advisory Group, LLC as the settlement administrator. The
20 court also incorporates by reference all findings and orders set forth in the Proposed Order submitted
21 in connection with the instant motion.

22 The final approval hearing is scheduled for January 12, 2027 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 32.

23 The motion for final approval shall be filed and served in accordance with Code of Civil Procedure
24 section 1005(b).

25 PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in light of the Court's ruling granting preliminary
26 approval, no appearance was required at the previously scheduled Case Management Conference.

27 PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the final approval hearing in this matter is
28 scheduled for January 12, 2027, at 8:30 a.m., in Department 32 of the above-entitled Court, located
at 10820 Justice Center Drive, Roseville, California 95678, before the Honorable Trisha J.
Hirashima.

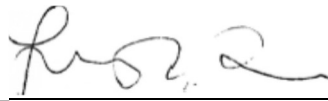
