The privacy and security of the personal information we maintain is of the utmost importance to Williams Brothers Construction Company, Inc. (“Williams Brothers”). We are writing to provide you with information regarding a data security incident that potentially involved your personal information. Please read this notice carefully, as it provides information about the incident, the complimentary identity monitoring services we are making available to you, and the significant measures we take to protect your information.

What Happened?

On or about January 10, 2026, Williams Brothers detected unauthorized activity associated with its network.

What We Are Doing.

Upon learning of the issue, we ensured the security of our systems, and we commenced a prompt and thorough investigation with the assistance of third-party cybersecurity experts. Following the completion of our investigation, it was determined that certain data was subject to unauthorized access between approximately January 10, 2026, to January 11, 2026. We conducted an extensive review of the impacted data and, upon concluding our investigation and review on August 3, 2026, we determined that the impacted data contained some of your personal information.

While cybersecurity threats continue to impact all of us, we are taking ever-increasing measures to protect the information entrusted to us. We continually evaluate and modify our practices and internal controls to enhance the security and privacy of your personal information. In response to this incident and through our continuing comprehensive review, we have strengthened our network and implemented additional security improvements recommended by third-party cyber security experts.

What Information Was Involved?

The impacted data contained some of your personal information, including your [REDACTED]

What You Can Do.

To date, we do not have evidence that your information has been used to commit financial fraud or identity theft. Nevertheless, out of an abundance of caution, we are offering a complimentary [REDACTED] membership for credit monitoring. This letter provides more information about the complimentary services, enrollment instructions, and other precautionary measures you can take to protect your personal information, including placing a Fraud Alert and Security Freeze on your credit files, and obtaining a free credit report. Additionally, you should always remain vigilant in reviewing your financial account statements and credit reports for fraudulent or irregular activity on a regular basis.
